

Korea Exchange Launched New Fixed-Income Securities Website

Ш	Korea Exchange (KRX, Chairman & CEO: Ji-won Jung) launched a new fixed-
	income securities website, hereinafter "FI-website", for foreign users on 2 July,
	2018. The site can be accessed at bond.krx.co.kr.
	The FI-website centralized information related to the KRX fixed-income market
	dispersed on the KRX official English website (global.krx.co.kr). It is expected to
	satisfy foreign users who had difficulties in finding fixed-income information on
	the existing website displaying informations by themes, not by instruments.
	KRX also made new contents about foreign investment, listing foreign bonds,
	and FAQ for foreign users such as investors, issuers, or researchers. Hence, a
	guide to KRX regulations for fixed-income market segments has been added to
	the FI-website for improving the accessibility of information.

	In other hand, KRX announced new English names of its four segments of the
	fixed-income market; KRX BondsAll, KRX LPB, KRX KTB and KRX Repo. KRX
	BondsAll is an exchange market for all investors where all listed bonds are
	traded; KRX LPB is a special purpose market for promoting the liquidity of
	License & Permit Bonds; KRX KTB is an inter-dealer market where Government
	bond Dealers trade Korea Treasury Bonds; and KRX Repo in an exchange
	market for trading of bonds repurchase agreement (Repo).
	KRX will step up its effort to get feedback from global bond issuers,
	international organizations related to fixed-income, etc. and supplement
	continuously. Subsequently KRX will roll out a section dedicated for green
	bonds on the FI-website for supporting domestic green finance market by
	enhancing public confidence and visibility of green bonds.
